#16 in 1847

- 1792 Jonathan Congdon, school master, sells for \$200 Lawful money to David Anthony a lot of land bounded: S by Angell Street 40'; thence N/ly at right angles 100'; thence running W/ly parallel with Angell Street 40'; bounded W/ly by William Barker 100'; together with a DWELLING HOUSE and other buildings...Deed Book 23.98
- 1798 CHACE INDEX CARDS: David Anthony...S on Angell Street; W on heirs of William Baker...Wood..25' x 43'...2 stories. Sink room 12' x 12'; Barn 14' x 30'; Shed for Wood..18' x 16'. Lot 40' x 100'.
- 1814 PROVIDENCE DIRECT TAX (to pay for the War of 1812) David Anthony.. N side of Angell Street. 40' front and 100' front to rear with one 2-story house 25' x 43'...wood. Stable..wood..14' x 28'. Value \$1200
- 1830 WILL: David Anthony: "To my beloved wife Dorcas Battey Anthony my Dwelling House and lot of land in Providence on Angell Street...." Wills 13.521
- 1838 POLICY RECORD: Dorcas Anthony. N side Angell Street...wood..26' front and 43' front to rear. Addition 12' x 13'..all 2 stories high front and rear and 3 stories high on W side. Woodhouse adjoining 10' x 15'...1 story high. Occupied for a Dwelling House..PR Vol 16.7216
 1845 PR. Vol 30. #12414
- 1846 WILL: Dorcas B Anthony..."I give and devise to my niece Dorcas B Harkness all the rest and residue of my estate both real and personal..." Wills 15.325
- 1876 WILL: Dorcas B Harkness: (wife of Thomas Harkness)..." I give and devise to my daughter Josephine M Harkness (subject to the life estate of my husband as tenant by courtesy thereof) my Homestead Estate where we now reside which was devised to me by my Aunt Dorcas B Anthony..all the rest and residue of my estate to my said husband'.W 25.356
- 1905 Josephine Anthony Harkness sells to R C Sanders " a certain lot of land N/ly on land of Elizabeth T Casey; E/ly on land of George Baker 100'; S/ly by Angell Street 40'; W/ly on land of Gilbert Carpenter..DB 476.141
- 1939 Property taxed to Mary C R Sanders (wid of Richard) and daughters Marguerite S Dudley and Mary E Spelman
- 1953 " " " " " " " taxed for property
- 1954 " " " " " " " Sell property to Ellen L O'Brien
