Built by Michael and Margaret Feeney in 1880

1879 Prescott O. Clarke conveys to Michael Feeney and Margaret Feeney: A certain parcel of land in the Easterly part of Providence comprising lots number 220 and 221 on a plat called "Grotto Reserve surveyed and platted May 1860 by Charles E. Paine". Said parcel is bounded on the Northerly by land of the Butler Hospital Corporation, Easterly by Lot Number 222, Southerly by Vernon Avenue and Westerly by Butler Avenue; it is a portion of the premises conveyed to me by deed from George L. Clarke Dated March 10, 1879 (November 17, 1879; Deed Book 304.337). Michael Feeney is a farmer.

1880 On June 1 there is no building on this lot; as of July 31 there is a building valued at \$1400 standing on 8000 square feet of land (Tax Ledger C3.3).
