737-9 CRANSTON STREET

Built by Josephine H. White in 1894

1894 Josephine H. White, wife of Ames A. White, a real estate agent, buys the property on Cranston Street from Isabella Tweed, executrix of the Estate of Amey W. Randall, and Charlotte Potter; the property is described as "Beginning at a point on the Northerly side of Cranston Street . . . (60) feet Northeasterly from the corner of Anthony Avenue and said Cranston Street thence Northeasterly on the line of said Cranston Street . . . (50) feet to the land of Candace Calvin and holding the width of fifty feet extends backward therefrom . . . (110) feet and contains . . . [5,500] sq. ft. of land" (Deed Book 384.365).

1894 Tax records show no building standing on the property as of March 1 (Tax Ledger Ell.79).

1894 Tax records show a new building, valued at \$8,600, standing on the property on June 1 (Tax Ledger Ell.79).
