Built 1892-1895...By 'Swift'?

- 1828 DIVISION of the Estate of Simeon H Olney:To Sarah Olney Martin Lot #5...to Sarah Coffin Olney and Ann Hopkins Olney Lot #3, #4, #1 (see map)...Deed Book 54.396
- 1844 Stephen Martin sells for \$670 to John B Hennessey, trader, a certain lot of land opposite the Blackstone Canal Basin, bounded: Beginning 100' E of Canal Street on a gangway...S by gangway 29'; E by Luther Forrestall 40'; N by Simeon Olney 29'; W by David Burt 40'...with a Dwelling House...Deed Book 92.113
- 1847 Luther Foristall sells for \$600 to John B Hennessey a certain lot of land with all buildings and improvements thereon, bounded: Beginning 125' E of Canal Street on a gangway...S by gangway 24'; and being 40' deep and being part of the Kelton Estate conveyed to me by William Batchelder in 1828 (55.138)...Deed Book 106.211
- 1854 Roger W Potter as guardian of Frances Hennessey, sells to John B Hennessey a certain lot of land, being Lot #5 (see map) assigned to Sarah O Martin in the partition of the estate of Siemon H Olney..DB 135.336
- 1855 Stephen Martin sells for \$900 to John B Hennessey a certain lot of land bounded: S by Canal Avenue (now Crockett Street) 50'; W by John B Hennessey 40'; N by Nathaniel J Rider 50'; E by John O Flavey... subject to lease given to John O Flavey in 1855 for 9½ years...the buildings on said lot above the underpinnings belong to said Flavey's lease...Deed Book 143.159
- 1892 William J Feeley and Mary G Feeley, his wife, in her fee, sell to Gustavus F and Edwin C Swift of Chicago, Illinois that certain tract of land with all buildings and improvements thereon between Canal and North Main Streets, being Lots #19, 22, 23, and 24 on Assessors Flat #10, and described in deeds to John B Hennessey...1 from Roger W Potter (135.336) 1 from Stephen Martin (143.159) and 1 from Luther Foristall (106.211) and 1 from Stephen Martin (92.113) being also portion of land set off to Mary G Feeley by the Commissioner in the petition for a partition of the John B Hennessey Estate in 1892 by the Supreme Court entitled... William J Feeley et ux vs James Murphy et al..Equity #3061.DB 371.489 *
- 1892 Property taxed to Gustavus F and Edwin C Swift of Illinois
- 1895 ~~Book~~
- 1903 Swift & Company taxed for this property
- 1935 Property taxed to Swift and Company of Illinois

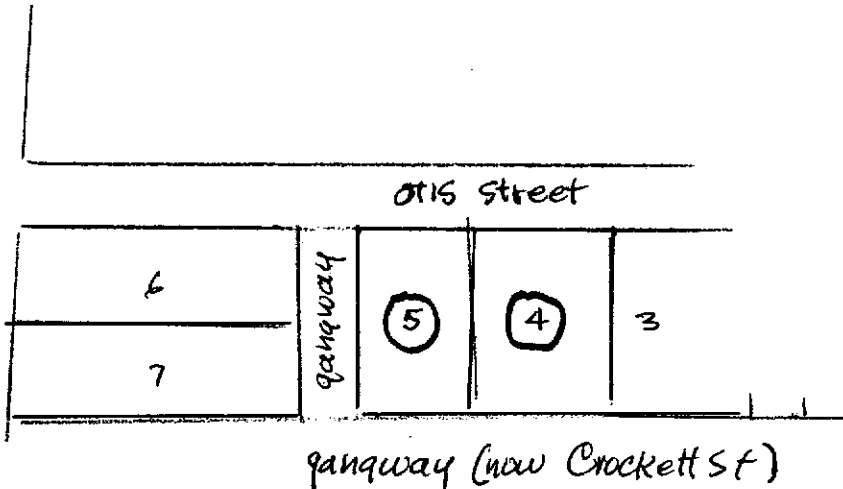
