1870 Property owned by the City of Providence

1874 WILL; Samuel Richards: "....I give and bequeath to my children Abbie M. Bliss, Malcolm W Richards, and Grace T Richards the revision of the remainder of my real estate namely, the income from the lease and improvements (the dwelling house) on three lots of land situated on Doyle Avenue in the City of Providence, said lots being a part of the Dexter Donation, #43, #44, #45, and leased from the City for the term of 40 years from 1870 as specified in the said lease, and all profit, income and advantages that may result therefrom, and after the decease of my beloved wife, Maria T Richards to have and hold the same to them, the said Abbie M Bliss, Malcolm W Richards, and Grace T Richards, their heirs and assigns from and after the decease of my said wife, to their use and behoof forever" Wills 29.434 (see map)

1936 Industrial Trust Company sells for \$11,500 to John J Burdick and Eleanor B Stalling those three lots of land being Lots #43, 44, and 45 on the S side of Doyle Avenue, bounded: N by Doyle Avenue 150'; E by Lot #46; 179.08' S 150'; W by lot #40 179.07'...Deed Book 789.410

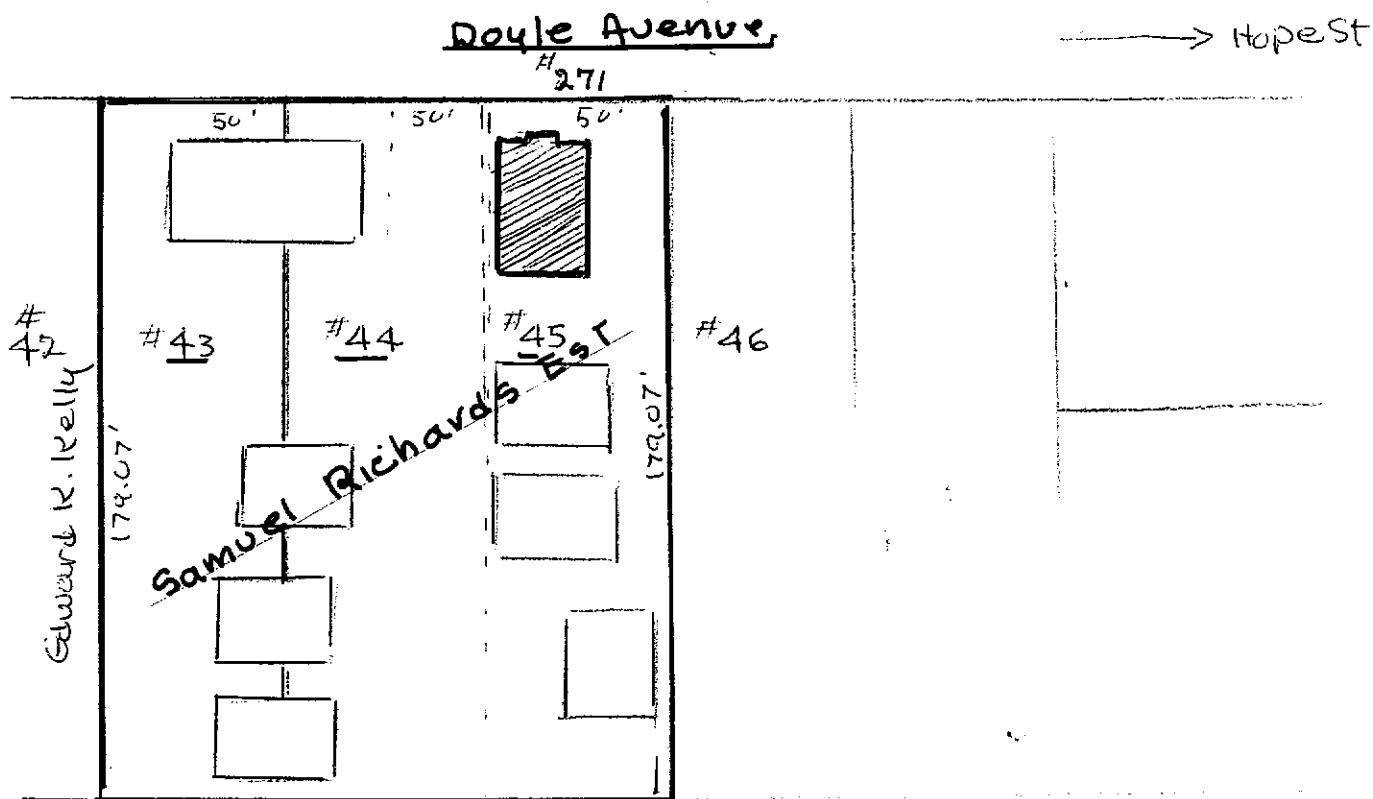
