1840 Halsey Street platted...Plat Book 2 page 5

1846 Halsey Street opened.

1846 Sarah Halsey sells for \$825 to Ruth W Helme, wife of Nathaniel G Helme a certain lot of land bounded: S by Halsey Street 56'; W by Lot #30 130 1/2'; N by Ezekiel Burr: E by Lot #28 being Lot #29 on the T L Halsey Plat (see map)...Deed Book 99.206

1853 Ruth W Helme, sells for \$2000 to William Helme et al 1 undivided 1/2 part of a certain lot of land bounded (as above) being lot #29 on Map of Halsey Estate by M B Lockwood in 1840 (see map)...it is the same lot conveyed by Sarah Halsey to grantor in 1846...the grantor intending to convey the buildings et al improvements thereon situated...Deed Book 133.235

1856 POLICY RECORD: Nathaniel G Helme, widow and heirs of...N side of Halsey Street...wood...38' x 26'. Addition 19' x 22'...all 2 stories high...occupied for a DWELLING HOUSE. A barn 50' from house...wood 20' x 24'...13' posts, part clapboard and painted..used for a private stable...PR Vol 59.25821

1898 WILL: Ruth W Helme...leaves ALL her property to daughter Elizabeth Helme who is also the executrix...PR Wills 4380...41.76

1904 MORTGAGE: Ellen Barnes, executor u/w Elizabeth Helme to David P Moulton the above property...Mtg 280.478

1924 WILL: Ellen R Barnes..." I authorize my executor, David P Moulton to sell my homestead Estate on Halsey Street...Wills 25072

This property changed ownership many times and was taxed...
