- 1833 Edward Carrington sells to Robert Hooper jr, ^{*} trustee of Timothy Wiggin of London, certain tracts of land for \$200,000, Item 4 being... " a certain tract of land bounded: N by Power Street 218'; E by Thayer Street; S by Williams Street 218'; W by Samuel W and Polly Greene"...Deed Book 66.256 *
- 1841 Robert Hooper jr, trustee of Timothy Wiggins, sells for \$1320 to Samuel and William Foster, a certain lot of land bounded: N by Power Street 60'; E by Christopher Peatee; S by Ira Armington 60'; W by Peleg A Rhodes and Charles Fisher and running the full width of the lot from Power to Williams Street.. "it being part of the lot formerly belonging to Edward Carrington"...DB 77.431
- 1843 Henry J Burroughs, accountant, (S & W Foster Co) and/or family lived here and until 1859..Prov.Dir.
- 1843 POLICY RECORD: Samuel and William Foster...wood...31' x 33'. Addition 22' x 16'. All 2 stories high. Occupied for a DWELLING HOUSE...Policy Record 27.10876
- 1859 John Luther, cashier, (Blackstone Canal National Bank) and/or family lived here and until 1877... Providence Directory
- 1879 Alfred K Hall, treasurer, Continental Steamboat Company, and/or family lived here and until 1882. Providence Directory.
- 1883 Emily Luther sells to William H Earle one certain lot of land with all buildings and improvements bounded; E by Samuel Slocum 85'; N by Power Street 50'; W by Charles E Tillinghast..

1884 William H Earle (Earle & Prew General Express)
and/or family lived here and until-----

1966 Property taxed to and occupied by the Earle family.

****NOTE:** Robert Hooper of Boston was the American receiver for Timothy Wiggin of London. Carrington owed W Wiggin a great deal of money when Wiggin went bankrupt in 1835-7....this almost ruined Carrington.

1968 Kenneth H Earle and Henry A Earle jr sell to Elizabeth W O'Hayer that parcel of land with all buildings and improvements thereon standing, on the S side of Power Street bounded: E by Malcolm Chace 85' and 000.7' W of Thayer Street; S by Lucio Gallo 50'; W by Brown University 85'; N by Power Street 50'...being the same premises conveyed by quit claim deed from Harry A Earle to the grantors in 1941 (DB 841.282) Deed Book 1146.468

1970 Robert E O'Hayer and wife Elizabeth W O'Hayer sell to Robert Scholes and Joan C Scholes, his wife, that parcel of land with all buildings and improvements thereon, having the same bounds as DB1146.468....Deed Book 1156.544

1972 Robert Scholes sells to Stanley Henshaw III and wife Leslie A. Henshaw that parcel of land with all buildings and improvements thereon bounded: E by Malcolm G Chace 85'(and 110.7' W of Thayer Street)S by Lucio Gallo 50'; W by Brown University 85'; N by Power Street 50'....Deed Book 1167.779
