- 1637 This property was the Home Lot of Thomas James
- 1663 Land owned by John Throckmorton
- Land owned by Alexander Bryant
- 1663
- 1663 WILL: John Whipple to son John his Home Lot..."BOUNDED S/ly by the Home Share of Thomas James, but now in possession of John Throckmorton"
- 1700 WILL: John Whipple jr to son John, his Home Lot...ALSO $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Home Log (of Thomas James) purchased by John Whipple gr of Alexander Bryant formerly belonging to John Throckmorton, adjoining that lot whereon said John Whipple's housing now stands. page 24

- 1707 John Whipple conveys all of his land, house and outhousing, in the Town of Providence on the E side of the River to son Joseph Whipple. DB 2.66
- 1717 Property owned by Joseph Whipple (see Map)
- c.1720 House erected...dated by style of architecture
- 1759 Property owned by John Whipple, son of Joseph
- 1770 Joseph Whipple sells for 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ Lawful Money to Jonathan Arnold, apothecary, a certain lot of land between Main Street and Back Street... Bounded S by a Lane or gangway laid out for the use as well as for a Public Lane by the name of Star Lane, bounded: W by Benjamin Hunt W, N, and E by my other lots. Said lot is in the form of a Parallelogram 80' dist ant from the E side of Main Street, thence 50' on Star Lane...Deed Book 18.393
- 1792 Jonathan Arnold sells the above property for 110 $\frac{1}{2}$ Lawful to Edard Thurber together with the Barn and Chaise House thereon standing. Deed Book...22.394
- 1792 Edward Thurber, merchant, sells for 90 L to Knight Dexter a certain lot of land together with barn and chaise house thereon standing, being the same grantor purchased of Jonathan Arnold in 1792. Bounded: S by Star Lane 64'; W by Benjamin Hunt and Recompense Healy 76'; N by Joseph Whipple 56'; E by Joseph Whipple 76'...Deed Book 23.95
- 1814 DIRECT TAX: (To pay for the War of 1812)..Ebenezer K Dexter...Star Street....ALS) a lot 60' x 80' bounded S by Star Street; W by widow Keene and late John Whipple; N and E by said Whipple's Estate.

- 1815 Ebenezer K Dexter sells the above property to Asa Newell for \$500, being the same that my honorable Father purchased of Edward Thurber in 1792. Deed Book 38.216
- 1819 Asa Newell sells for \$1300 to Sturgis Davis, goldsmith, together with the Dwelling House, barn and other buildings thereon standing a certain lot of land, being the same I purchased of E K Dexter in 1815. Bounded S by Star Lane 64'; W by Healy and Hunt 78'; N by John Whipple 56'; E by John Whipple heirs...Deed Book 43.252
- 1824 POLICY RECORD: Sturgis Davis..N side Star Street...wood...21' x 22' front to rear...2 stories high in front and rear...occupied as a Dwelling House...PR Vol 2.2501 (#10 Star Street)
- 1834 See Map
- 1840 POLICY RECORD: Sturgis Davis...N side Star Street...wood...21' x 22' 2 Stories high in front and rear...3 stories high on W side...occupied for a Dwelling House...Vol 19.8105 (#10 Star Street)
- 1845 DIVISION of the ESTATE OF STURGIS DAVIS:..." to Eliza W Davis...Parlor, 1 garret and front Parlor in the lower part of the small House with c. 12 3/4' of land adjoining. To Samuel Davis all of the small house with the exception of the front parlor with 12 3/4' of land adjoining the above. Deed Book 97.248
- 1872 Heirs of Sturgis Davis sell to Sullivan Moulton 1 certain lot of land with TWO Dwelling Houses on the N/ly side of Star Street. Bounded: S by Star Street 64'; W by grantee and Joel Metcalf 78'; N by heirs of Joel Metcalf 56'; E by Jacob Seagrave 76';...being the same conveyed to the late Sturgis Davis by Asa Newell in 1819...Deed Book 237.509
