- 1798 CHACE NOTES: Richard Brown..W by Benefit Street; N by Bernon Dunn; 24'x24'...2 stories...wood...almost in ruins...no windows...unoccupied.
- 1812 Samuel Jackson, administrator of the Estate of Richard Brown sells to Cyrus Cole...ALSO..a lot of land at the N end of Benefit Street bounded: W by Benefit Street 81'; S 62½'; E 60'; N 66'...DB 36.55
- 1814 DIRECT TAX: Cyrus Cole...Benefit Street...1 lot 40'x120' with a dwelling house..(not this house) 2 stories high on 1 side and 3 stories on another..36'x24'.
- 1825 Anne Townsend by act of the House of the General Assembly sells for \$1500 to Joseph Veazie, goldsmith and jeweller, a..ALSO a certain lot of land which the said Cyrus Cole mortgaged to Charles Feké in 1812. (35.376)...DB 48.347
- 1844 POLICY RECORD: Joseph Veazie...E side Benefit Street...wood...30' x40'. Addition 16'x20'..all 2 stories high front and rear...occupied for a DWELLING HOUSE...PR 29.11614
- 1869 Amasa S Westcott, commissioner for the Superior Court in Equity #801 for partition of an Estate sells for \$~~800~~ to Josiah W Crooker, the highest bidder at public auction, a lot of land on the E side of Benefit Street with all buildings and improvements bounded: W by Benefit Street 87½'; S by the City of Providence; E by Morris Deming and Elizabeth Helme 75 3/4'; N by land this day sold to Franklin Steere...DB 184.439

This property changed ownership several times and

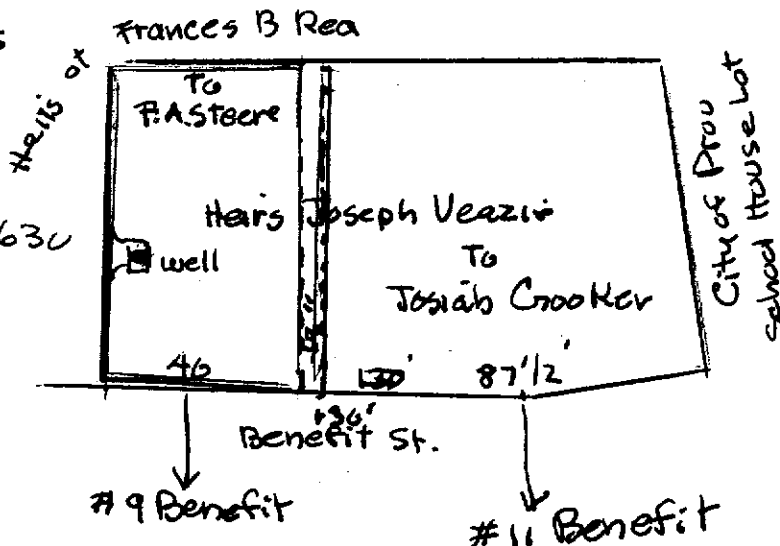
