- 1847 Moses B Ives and Henry B Robers in trust for Eliza B Rogers, wife of Joseph, sell to Isaac H Cady and Prudence B Updike for \$2000 a part of a triangular piece of land. To Isaac H Cady as his, so much of the trianggle piece of land North, and to said Prudence B Updike so much as lies South of the division line described in the deed of partition in 1846.DB 102.290
- 1847 Walter W Updike and Prudence B Updike his wife quit claim to Isaac H Cady (being 77' on Benefit Street)...DB 102.141
- 1846 Walter Updike and wife Prudence B sell for \$2500 to Henry Lippitt with gangway privileges a certain lot of land bounded: W by Benefit St 39'; S by grantors; E by John Pitman 39'; N by I Cady...DB 102.98
- 1847 Henry Lippitt sells for \$2500 to Patience W^M Bush wife of Daniel a certain lot of land bounded W by Benefit Street 39'; S by Prudence Updike; N by Isaac Cady; E by John Pitman...DB 102.342

1855 POLICY RECORD: Daniel Bush...E side of Benefit Street...Brick...being the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of a double house...26'x44' with addition of 10'x17'...all 3 stories high in front and rear. Another addition 13'x19'...2 stories high and occupied for a DWELLING HOUSE...PR 56.24766

- 1923 Natalie Bush et al quit claim to L Earle Rowe a certain lot of land bounded: W by Benefit Street 39.9'; N by A L Kenyon 75.74'; E by gangway and Aldrich and Watrous; S by Brick Wall and Henry Hidden 76.55'...DB 641.115
