- 1845 Daniel Stillwell sells for \$400 to Abraham Stillwell a certain lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon on the S/ly corner at the intersection of Benefit and Transit Streets, late the Homestead Estate of our honoured Father Daniel Stillwell, ..Deed Book 110.16

1848 LEASE: Abraham Stillwell farm lets to Albert G Stillwell a certain lot of land bounded: E by Benefit Street 45'; S by Samuel Guild 80'; W by Jacob Morgan and Joseph A Chedel; N by lessor. All buildings that are or may be built shall be and remain liable for the payment of the annual rent...DB 148.478

- 1870 Samuel S Stillwell et al quit claim to Albert G Stillwell 1 certain lot of land with all buildings and improvements (same bounds as 247.456) being the S/ly part of the Estate formerly belonging to Abraham Stillwell...DB 191.195
- 1873 Tax Ledger - Albert G Stillwell - Land 2208 - Bldg - 2800 - Series C. 6228
- 1874 Albert G Stillwell sells for \$1,000 to Mary E Hinds wife of William H Hinds a lot of land with all buildings and improvements bounded: E by Benefit Street 46'; S by Samuel Guild 80'; W by J Morgan and J A Chedel 46'; N by Stillwell the N line being 50' S on Benefit Street from the corner of Transit Street...DB 247.456
- 1874 Tax Ledger - Mary E Hinds - Land 2600 - Bldg 5,008 - Series C. 3,356
- 1920 Ellen M Hinds (unmarried) sells to Louis Berger that lot of land with all improvements being the same premises conveyed to grantor by ded of Mary E Hinds in 1913 (DB 542.326)...DB 594.250
- 1922 Property taxed to Shea and Rebecca Wallace
- 1923 Toney A and Richard Solomon and Toney Charley taxed for this property
- 1932 Property taxed to Richard Solomon
- 1934 Rose Solomon wife of Richard is owner of the property
