1911 The building used as a Mission House *

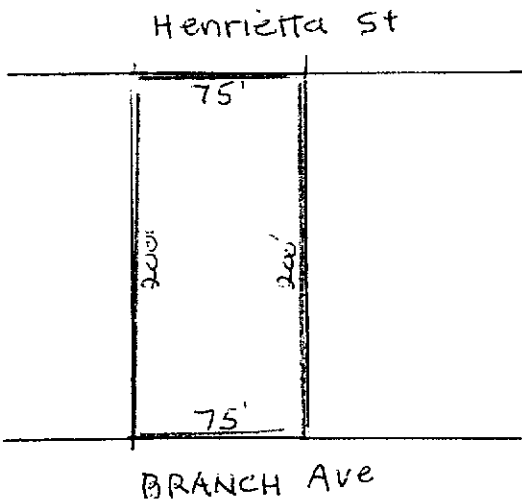
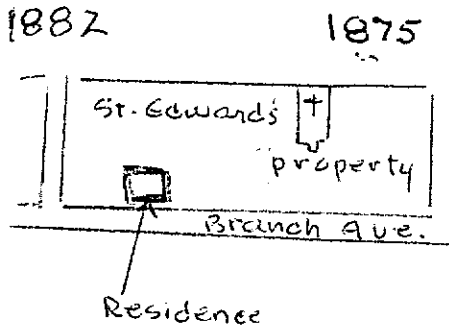
1912 St Edward's Church sell to Mary F Tully et al that certain lot of land and all

Avenue bounded: N by Branch Avenue 75'; W by McGhan 200'; S by Henri-
