196 CALLA STREET

Built by Charles D. Reynolds in 1900

1899 On March 20 Frank B. Reynolds acquires four lots on the Southerly side of Calla Street, laid out and designated as lots 39, 40, 41 and 42 on a plat of house lots (formerly) in Cranston belonging to Francis Haswill surveyed and platted by Cushing & Walling September 24, 1847, a copy of which is in Plat Book No. 10 pages 11 and 12 (Deed Book 426.50).

On October 4 Frank Reynolds conveys above property to Charles D. Reynolds for \$10 (Deed Book 424.136).

1900 Intention to Build #13576 for a house on the South side of Calla St. near Roger Williams Park is filed by Asa R. Ball, Builder, for Mr. C. D. Reynolds.

Providence Directory for year commencing 6/15/00 lists Charles D. Reynolds, draftsman, at 196 Calla.
