- 1849 INDENTURE...Division of the Estate of Thomas Lloyd Halsey: Set off to Thomas L Halsey party of the first part....Lot #303 on the E/ly side of Congdon Street...Book of Plats #2...page 22...DB 117.353
- 1850 Thomas L Halsey sells for \$900 to Elizabeth C Read a certain lot of land situated on the E/ly side of Congdon Street, being Lot #303 on Plat #2 of the Halsey Estate and bounded: W by Congdon Street 55'; N by Lot #304 130'; E by lot #302 55' and was set off to grantor in the partition of the Halsey Estate in 1849...DB 118.234
- 1851 William M Read and wife Elizabeth C Read sell for \$1200 to Mary B Parker wife of John A Parker of Bristol a certain lot of land, being lot conveyed by deed to Elizabeth C Read from Thomas M Halsey in 1850 bounded: W by Congdon Street 56'; N by lot #304 130'; E by lot #302; S by the late Samuel G Arnold 130'....DB 124.167
- 1853 POLICY RECORD: John A Parker...E side of Congdon Street...wood... 27' x 34'...with an addition 23' x 15' and another 6' x 13'...all two stories high front and rear...occupied for a DWELLING HOUSE. Volume 51...#22370
- 1855 Mary B Parker sells to Mary B Fish a certain lot of land with a Dwelling House and other improvements being the same conveyed to the grantor from William M Read and wife in 1851...163.401
- 1862 Property was taxed to Elizabeth Ballou Keith and to the following persons in the year designated:
