1785 Joseph Cooke, mariner for 18 £ lawful money sells to Thomas Thayer a certain lot of land bounded: S by Transit Street 33'; E by D Tillinghast 88'; N by Carnold 33'; W by J Cooke 88'..21/329

1826 Nancy Chafee et al for \$890 sell to Ann Chaffee and Riley Brown a certain piece of land conveyed by Joseph Cooke to Thomas Thayer in 1795 together with a 2 story DWELLING HOUSE as recorded in 21/329...52/77

1834 Policy Record: Vol II. 5290

1835 Riley Brown, housewright, for \$600 sells to George W Ormsbee 1 undivided $\frac{1}{2}$ part of a certain lot of land with all buildings, being the same conveyed to the grantor et al by Thomas Thayer et al in 1826 ...67/97

1849 Russell Clapp, assignee of George Fisher (heir of George W Ormsbee) for \$50 to John Fisher the highest bidder at public auction of the Estate conveyed to me by assignment in 1848.. a certain lot of land with buildings and improvements being #53 formerly #38 Transit Street being occupied and the life estate pf George Fisher...113/337

1854 Property is taxed to George W Ormsbee heirs and was in the same family until 1935.
