- 1786 John Innes Clarke and Joseph Nightingale sell to Welcome Arnold a certain lot of land bounded E by Cooke burying lot 90'; S by Christopher Sheldon 700'; W by J Cooke 90'; N by Transit Lane 700'..being #11 and #15 on the lately called Clarke Lots..21/363
- 1819 Welcome Arnold heirs sell to Zachariah Allen..."also a certain lot of land on the S side of Transit Street on which it measures 700'; extending S/ly to a partition wall which separates the lots lately belonging to Captain C Sheldon about 90'; W on land formerly belonging to Governor Cooke or Jesse Cooke90'; E/ly by lot known as the Cooke's burying lot with a DWELLING HOUSE thereon standing it being the same as #11 and #15 lately called the Clarke lots purchased by my late father Welcome Arnold in 1786...42/296
- 1838 Zachariah and Eliza Harriet Allen sell for \$300 to William J Tilley a certain lot of land bounded E by CBarker; S by stone wall dividing land from Sheldon lots 50'; N by Transit Street...72/144
- 1840 Z Allen and wife Eliza H Allen for \$300 sell to William J Tilley a certain lot of land bounded E by William J Tilley 90'; S by fence 46'; W by Nathan Kent 90'; N by Transit Street 46', said lot comprising all the land between said Kent's and Tilley's lots

- 1847 William J Tilley lived here...Prov Dir..also Albert Cottrell
- 1903 Samuel Nightingale, commissioner, sells for William J and Simeon B Tilley to James O'Brian and wife Mary, the highest bidders at public auction two parcels of land with Dwelling House..bounded: N by Transit Street 46'; E by J Miller 100'; S by William Murphy 46'; W by J O'Connor....457/198
- 1950 Property was taxed to Adelaide Simmons
