- 1786 John Innes Clarke and Joseph Nightingale sell to Welcome Arnold a certain lot of land bounded E by Cooke's burying lot 90'; S by Christopher Sheldon 700'; W by J Cooke 90'; N. by Transit Lane 700'; ...being #11 and #15 on the lately called Clarke Lots...21/363
- 1819 Welcome Arnold heirs sell to Zachariah Allen..."also a certain lot of land on the S side of Transit Street on which it measures 700'; extending S/ly to a partition wall which separates the lots lately belonging to Captain C Sheldon about 90'; and S by said Cheldon 700'; W on land formerly belonging to Governor or Jesse Cooke 90'; E on lot known as the Cooke's burying lot with a DWELLING HOUSE thereon standing, it being the same lots purchased by my late father Welcome Arnold in 1786...42/296
- 1844 Z Allen and wife Eliza Harriet Allen sell for \$300 to Isaiah Barney a certain lot of land beginning 79½' east of the east side of Brook Street and running 50' on Transit Street; E by Jared Dodge 98'; S by grantor 55'....89/86
- 1847 Isaiah Barney sells for \$300 to David W Barney a certain lot of land and is the same lot conveyed to grantor by deed from Z Allen and wife in 1844. David W Barney lived here...Prov Dir
- 1909 Jennie H Shaw, the only heir-at-law of David W Barney sells a certain lot of land to James Callahan bounded N by Transit Street 40'; E by Jared Dodge 91½'; S by Simmons 36'; W by Simmons 110'...502/79
- 1917 Property was taxed to James Callaghan heirs
- 1944 Property was taxed to John J Amaral and wife Diamantina.

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
