Chapter II (1776 - 1803) page 16:

"Some time after , when the schools had gone fairly into operation... the school committee made their first visit to this school. When opposite the residence of an objector I was deputed to invite him to go with us for the first visit of examination to the TRANSIT STREET School "

From Deed Records at City Hall:

In 1802, James Ormsbee sells and quit claims to Samuel Nightingale in his capacity of Town Treasurer, for \$586.95" all interest I have in the first Story or Cellar part of the School House in the 3rd District in the S/ky part of Town of Providence, being the same School House I built for said Town...Deed Book 27.449
