- 1783 JOHN ORMSBEE ET AL SELL A LOT OF LAND TO THOMAS BENNETT BOUNDED N BY TRANSIT LAND 12'; E BY GRANTEE AND S AND W BY GRANTOR...20.690
- 1787 THOMAS BENNETT SELLS FOR 32^l LAWFUL MONEY TO JOSEPH PECK A CERTAIN LOT OF LAND BOUNDED: N BY TRANSIT LANE 44'; E BY JOSHUA WHITING 88'; S BY C SHELDON 44'; W BY GRANTOR....21.504
- 1794 THOMAS BENNETT, INNKEEPER, SELLS FOR \$132 TO JOSEPH PECK, A CERTAIN LOT OF LAND BOUNDED: N BY TRANSIT STREET 22'; E BY JOSEPH PECK 88'; S BY C SHELDON 44'; W BY THOMAS BENNETT 88' "RESERVING TO MYSELF THE PRIVILEGE OF MOVING OFF A BUILDING THEREON STANDING"...23.399
- ? 66' → 1795 JOSEPH PECK, MERCHANT, SELLS FOR 120 SPANISH MILLED DOLLARS TO HANNAH AND MARTHA HACKER, SINGLEWOMEN, A CERTAIN LOT OF LAND BOUNDED: N BY TRANSIT LANE 66'; E BY JAMES PITCHER 88'; S BY C SHELDON 66'; E BY THOMAS BENNETT 88'....24.68
- 1796 HANNAH HACKER ET AL SELL TO ABIGAIL ORMSBEE FOR \$218 A CERTAIN LOT OF LAND BEING THE W MOST $\frac{1}{2}$ PART WHICH GRANTOR PURCHASED OF GEORGE PECK IN 1795...24/282 29.4' ON TRANSIT ST.
- 1797 JAMES AND ABIGAIL ORMSBEE SELL FOR \$50 TO CALVIN WALKER THE LOT OF LAND OF THE ABOVE PROPERTY WHICH IS THE W[?] MOST $\frac{1}{2}$ PART OF LAND PURCHASED OF JOSEPH PECK IN 1795.....24/377
- 1798 CHACE PLACES PROPERTY HERE.....OWNED BY CALVIN WALKER
- 1824 CALVIN WALKER HOUSEWRIGHT, SELLS FOR \$250 TO DANIEL RUSSELL A CERTAIN LOT OF LAND WHICH HANNAH HACKER ET AL PURCHASED OF JOSEPH PECK IN 1795 WITH 10' GANGWAY LEFT FOR MUTUAL USE VIZ: 5' E OF THIS LOT AND 5' W OF ADJOINING LOT...42/270
- 1824 DANIEL RUSSELL, GROCER, LIVED HERE....PROV. DIR.
- 1832 DANIEL RUSSELL, SHOEMAKER, LIVED HERE....PROV. DIR.
- 1847 DANIEL RUSSELL'S WIDOW LIVED HERE...PROV. DIR.
- 1854 PROPERTY TAXED TO DANIEL RUSSELL HEIRS
- 1885 G WESTCOTT PERKINS ET AL SELL TO THOMAS G AND PHEBE HOWLAND A CERTAIN LOT OF LAND WITH DWELLING HOUSE BEING THE SAME CONVEYED TO DANIEL RUSSELL BY CALVIN WALKER IN 1824...332.246
